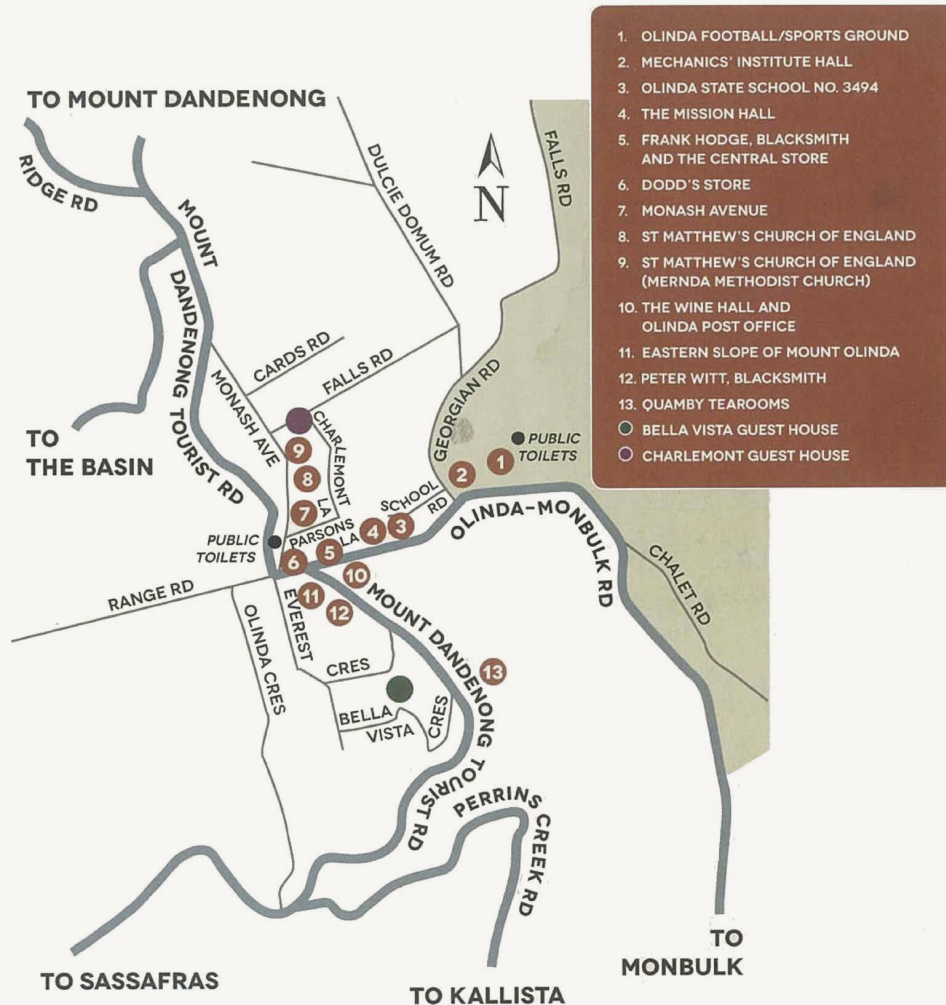

DID YOU KNOW?

Olinda Creek used to be called Running Creek. It was renamed in 1858 after Victoria's Acting Surveyor General's daughter - Alice Olinda Hodgkinson.
